When protecting individuals from **Radicalisation & Extremism** and carrying out our responsibilities under the **Prevent Duty**, we need to know what changes could make an individual vulnerable and what signs to look out for.

Common Signs

- Changes in behaviour/ mood and language used;
- Expressing strong/ extreme political or radical views;
- Appear increasingly sympathetic to terrorist acts;
- Changes in appearance;
- Spending excessive time on their own and/or on the internet - reclusive;
- Seeking to hide view/opinion, activities etc.
